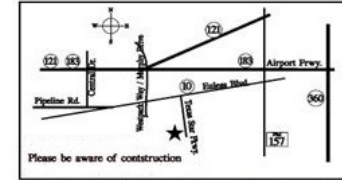

Founded and currently serves as the Director of Save a Smile led by Cook Children's serving indigent children pre-kindergarten through sixth grade in targeted schools in Tarrant County. She also works with numerous local collaborations and community groups on children's oral health issues and serves on the legislative committee for the Children's Oral Health Coalition. Dr. Fuqua has been instrumental in developing the first fully integrated medical/dental home for the Cook Children's Health Care System. She was recently appointed as a Board of Trustee for Texas Health Institute and serves as the President for the Tarrant County Leadership Board of the Crohn's and Colitis Foundation. Dr. Fuqua is a member of countless dental, civic and professional business organizations. In her spare time, she is a wife and mother of two wonderful young girls.
